

Monash University English Language Requirements – November 2019 (Monash Malaysia)

All students applying to study on exchange or study abroad at Monash University must show evidence of having met the University's English language requirements, using one of the following methods.

1. English at Secondary School

Students from the following countries who studied English at upper secondary school can provide their school certificate to show they achieved the relevant score listed below or higher.

Denmark	<i>Bevis for Studentereksamen (STX)</i>	English A - Overall average of 7 English B - Overall average of 10
Finland	<i>Ylioppilastutkintoto/Lukion Päättötodistus</i>	Score of 7 in English
Germany	<i>Abitur also known as Zeugnis der Allgemeinen Hochschulreife</i>	Score of 7 points (satisfactory) in advanced/ <i>Leistungskurs</i> English (<i>Abitur</i> examination subject)
Netherlands	<i>Voorbereidend Wetenschappelijk Onderwijs (VWO)</i>	Score of 8 in English
Norway	<i>Vitnemål fra den Videregående Skole</i>	Grade 3 in final year English
Sweden	<i>Högskoleförberedande Examen</i>	Overall average of all English subjects undertaken with a Grade C
	<i>Avgångsbety/Slutbetyg Gymnasieskolan</i>	Overall average of all English subjects completed with a grade 'VG' or above

Note that the upper secondary school certificate from the above countries must not be older than 5 years at commencement of their exchange or study abroad program on **27 July 2020 for Semester Two, 2020**.

2. English test

Students can provide evidence that they have sat for an approved English test report (see below). This test cannot be older than 2 years at commencement of their exchange or study abroad program on **27 July 2020**. For more and latest information please see the Monash Admissions [website](#).

3. Common European Framework of Reference for Languages System (CEFR)

Students can now produce a certificate of English language proficiency provided by their home institution with a minimum overall grade of C1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages System (CEFR).
