

## Incoming Study Abroad Students Proposed Study Plan

The Proposed Study Plan must be submitted as part of your application for a study abroad term at the University of Victoria, and should be discussed with your program advisor prior to submission. It is your responsibility to review your study plan to ensure that the courses are available and that you meet the course prerequisites.

## Course selection

Please email studyabroad@uvic.ca to request a Recommended Course List, or search the courses we offer via the Academic Calendar to learn about the courses you can request. Course offerings per year/term won't be finalized until the course schedule is released in mid-May, so we advise you to select some additional "fall-back" courses.

- If your study plan includes courses that have prerequisites, you must complete and submit a Course Request Form (CRF) prior to course registration. CRFs will be provided after you've been admitted.

List at least six (6) course requests for your study abroad term. Most students take 3-5 courses per term, and you should ask your program advisor how many courses/credits you are required to take during your study abroad. Please note that 1.5 units is equivalent to approximately 6 ECTS credits.
